This study could change your life, by changing your relationship with money.

Stuff. And more stuff. And even more stuff. In Defying Gravity, Tom Berlin takes a look at the difference between "want" and "need" and illustrates how possessions can create an unbearable weight on our lives. He shows us how too much stuff affects our ability to serve and thrive, and then he helps us explore what is required to sustain a vibrant life.

It may come as a surprise to many, but faithful churchgoers do not necessarily regularly support their church financially. 
